



This forum highlights next-generation vaccines against major diseases including swine fever virus, innovative bacteriophage applications as antibiotic alternatives, and biotechnological strategies specifically designed to increase weaned piglet numbers under tropical environmental conditions, addressing one of Asia's most pressing production challenges.

SUSTAINABLE SHRIMP PRODUCTION THROUGH EFFICIENT AND CIRCULAR PRACTICES

The session includes demonstrations of precision feeding systems using AI/IoT technologies and introduces Wolffia as a low-carbon protein platform for sustainable aquafeed, showcasing how selective breeding, genomic technologies, and smart automation create environmentally sound and economically viable shrimp farming operations.




